Team sponsorships start at \$1,000, and 100 percent of the net proceeds benefit the Cancer Therapy & Research Center (CTRC) at The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. As of July 17, platinum \$5,000 sponsors for this year's event included AT&T, Cemex, Komatsu (dealers: Waukesha Pearce, Kirby-Smith), and Ryan Construction.

Over the past 15 years, Vulcan's event has raised more than \$1.3 million to benefit the CTRC, the region's only National Cancer Institute (NCI)-designated Cancer Center. The 2008 event raised more than \$164,000.

"Cancer has touched the Vulcan family numerous times since we did our first Funshoot in 1994," said Tom Hill, president, Vulcan Materials, Southwest Division. "Our employees would like this to be the landmark year that cumulative donations to benefit the CTRC reach the \$1.5 million mark."

An event that annually attracts nearly 400 participants takes a lot of careful preparation. A team of committed employees from Vulcan Materials plans and implements the entire event. For example, on the day of the event, employees fire up a grill so large that six men can cook at a time. They'll use up half a cord of wood before the day is over.
